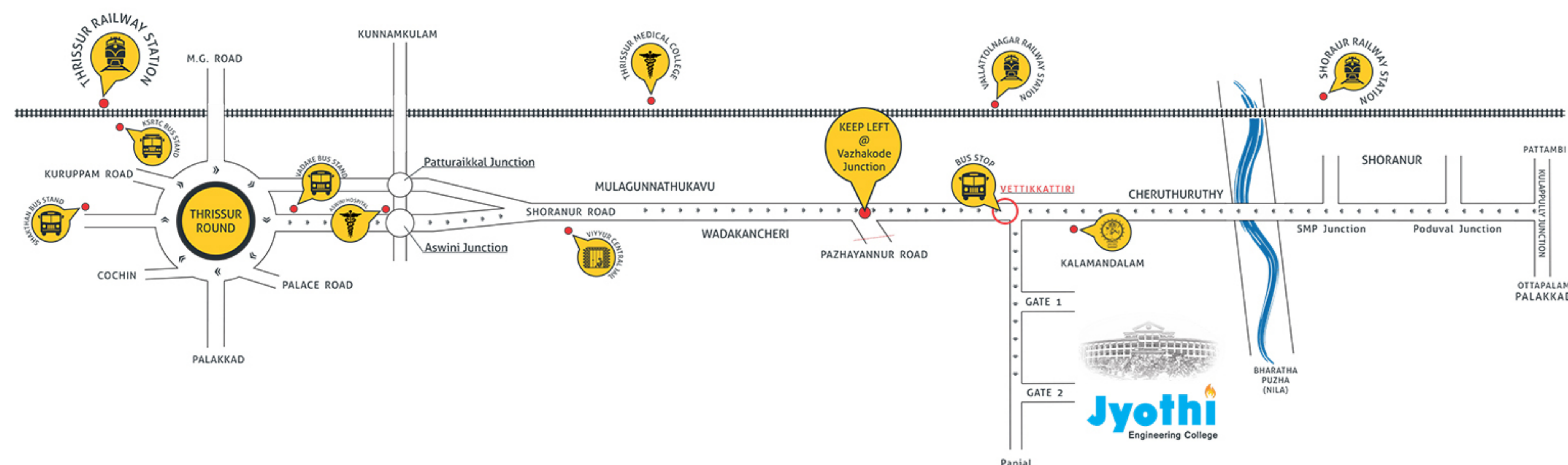
Objectives
