On the day of the meet students were joining at the right time. Camp and other work activities were the main topics. And we were able to convince them the importance of the camp.




Interactive session


The students who performed well had a selection procedure in order for our enrollment. About 120 students have registered for joining our NSS unit.






Engineer's Day - Online Quiz competition






