

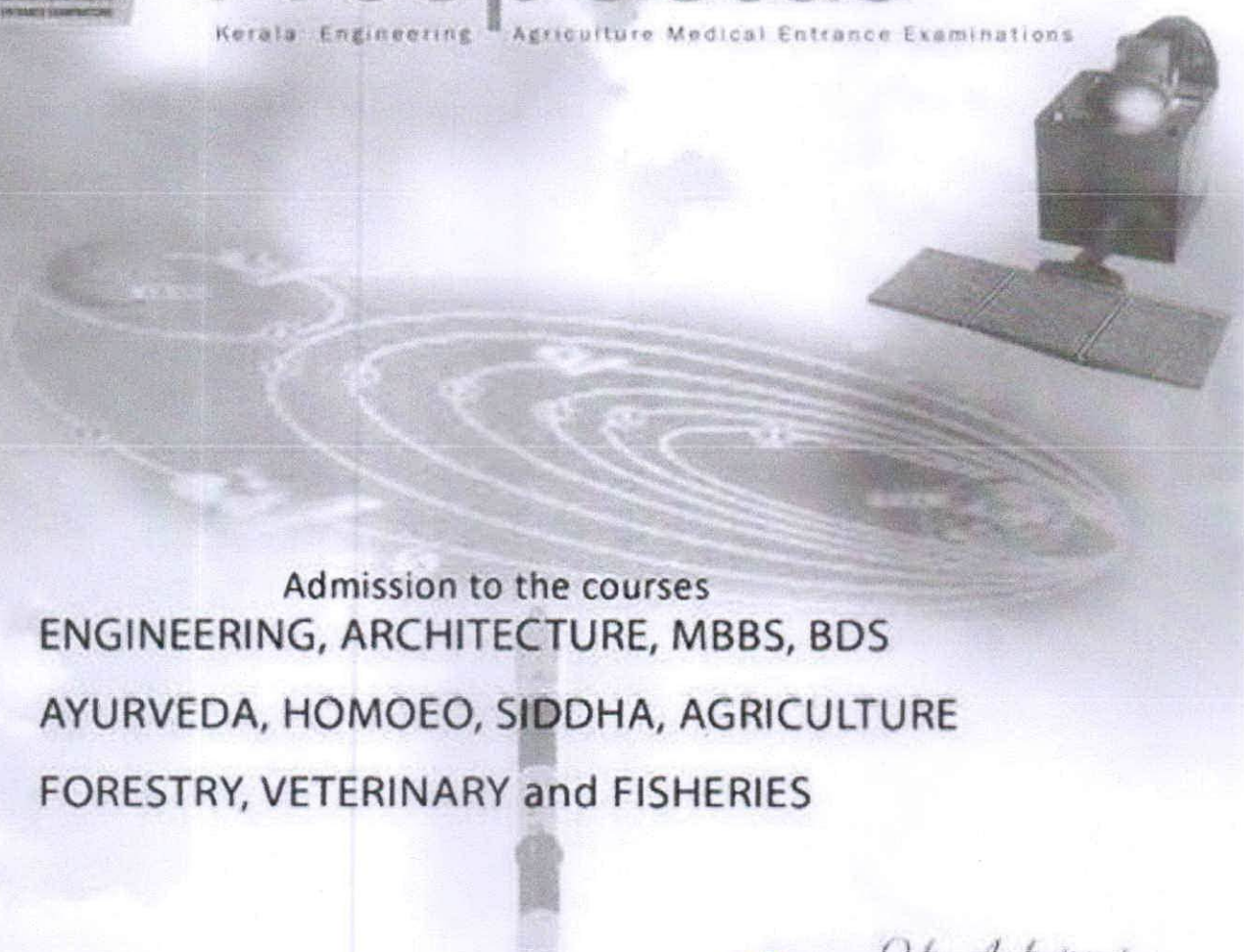

The seats reserved under All India Quota for MBBS and BDS Courses in Government Medical/Dental Colleges will be allotted by the Director General of Health Services, New Delhi, on the basis of the rank obtained in the All India Pre-Medical/Pre-Dental Entrance Examination conducted by the CBSE, New Delhi as per the directions contained in the Supreme Court Judgement dated 21.07.1986. Details of seats are given in Annexure III (2).

(b) **Reservation of seats for Nominees:**

- (i) **Nominees of the Government of India:** The Government of India, subject to the eligibility conditions in clause 6, will make Nominations to these seats. The distribution of seats under this category and other details in respect of MBBS/BDS courses are available in Annexure III (2).
- (ii) **Nominees from Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands** : These seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Nominations to these seats will be made by the Administration of that Union Territory and the candidates must possess the requisite qualifications as provided under Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
- (iii) **Nominees from Lakshadweep:** Seats are reserved for the candidates of Kerala origin settled in Lakshadweep. The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that Union Territory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
- (iv) **Nominee from Jammu & Kashmir:** One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. Medical College (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP, CMC and IDM) for a nominee from Jammu & Kashmir. Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government Medical College, Thrissur [See Annexure III(2)].

Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority by **26.09.2016**. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categories on **27.09.2016** itself. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.

The candidates should be sponsored by the Administration of that Union Territory and must possess the requisite qualifications as per Clause 6. The distribution of seats is given in Annexure III (2).
- (iv) **Nominee from Jammu & Kashmir:** One seat for MBBS will be reserved in a Govt. Medical College (by rotation every year in the order TVM, ALP, KTM, TCM, KKM, MLP and CMC) for a nominee from Jammu & Kashmir. Candidate to this seat should be sponsored by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through the Higher Education Secretary of the State. This year, the seat will be reserved in Government Medical College, Kozhikode [See Annexure III(2)].

Admission to the seats under 4.1.11(b)(i) to 4.1.11(b)(iv) above should be completed by the admitting authority by **26.08.2017**. The Director of Medical Education will inform the CEE, through Government of Kerala, the un-availed seats in these categories on **27.08.2017** itself. Such seats will be reverted to the mandatory quota.

PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO P.G. DEGREE COURSE IN
ENGINEERING FOR THE YEAR 2019-20

I. General

Post Graduate Degree Courses in Engineering are being offered to the graduates in Engineering, in various Engineering Colleges in the state for awarding Masters Degree in the appropriate branches by the Universities concerned. The course shall extend over a period of 24 months consisting of 4 semesters.

II. Institutions and Intake

The details of institutions offering P.G. Course in various disciplines towards which centralized allotment will be done and the intake are given in the Annexure A and B. For filling up of the 50% Seats in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges in the State, the concerned Principals should resort the Rank list published by the Directorate of Technical Education complying the reservation norms as mentioned in clause IV of the prospectus. In the absence of candidate in the rank list, other eligible candidates can be considered.

III. Fee structure

IV Reservation of seats

- a) 30% Seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC). Candidates belonging to SEBC (OBC) and OEC should produce a certificate to the extent that the candidate belongs to the community which is

designated as an SEBC (OBC) / OEC and does not belong to the category of Creamy Layer.

- b) 10% Seats are reserved for SC/ST Candidates. (SC-8%, ST-2%)
- c) The seats reserved for each category will be distributed among the eligible communities by observing the pattern of general reservation rules of the state.
- d) 5% seats are reserved for different abled candidates.
- e) 15% seats relating to management quota in T K M College of Engineering, Kollam, M A College of Engineering, Kothamangalam and N S S College of Engineering, Palakkad will be filled by the Management (For courses in Annexure A).
- f) 16 seats are earmarked in Govt. Engineering Colleges, Aided Engineering Colleges and in Government Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges in the state for faculty from Govt. Polytechnics to pursue M Tech Programme under Quality Improvement Programme. Similarly, 4 seats are earmarked for faculty from Aided Polytechnics in the state for the next two consecutive academic years from 2019-2020 to 2020-2021 as per the G.O(Ms)No.137/2019/H Edn dated 21.05.2019. Notification will be issued separately in this regard from the Office of Director of Technical Education.
- g) The Management seats and sponsored seats if any in the Government Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges (institutions mentioned in Annexure B) will be filled by the institutions themselves. If any sponsored seat remains unfilled, it can be converted to merit seats and the institutions themselves can fill the above seats by inviting separate applications from among the candidates figuring in the rank list published by the Director of Technical Education on merit basis and following reservation policy.

V. Eligibility for admission

- a) The candidates shall be an Indian National.
- b) The candidates should have studied the Graduate course in an institution approved by the AICTE / Deemed Universities in India.
- c) Candidates should have a minimum of 60% aggregate marks in the Engineering Degree examination. For SC/ST candidates a pass in the Engineering Degree course is sufficient. For SEBC (OBC) students, a minimum of 54% aggregate marks in the Engineering Degree examination is mandatory.
- d) Candidates, who have passed AMIE / AMIETE Examinations and satisfying the following conditions, are eligible for admission.
 - 1) They must have valid GATE score.
 - 2) A minimum of 55% marks for section B in AMIE/AMIETE examination.
- e) Candidates who have appeared for the final semester examination can also apply, provided he / she has passed all the subjects up to and including the 6th semester exam (8th semester for B. Arch students). Confirmation of admission of such candidates shall

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be subject to the production of qualifying degree –before the date stipulated by the affiliated University.

- f) Admission shall normally be restricted to those with valid GATE score. However, this stipulation is relaxed in the case of Sponsored candidates.
- g) In case seats remain vacant due to lack of candidates with valid GATE score, candidates from Kerala State without valid GATE score will be considered against such vacancies. If seats are still remaining vacant, candidates from other states will be considered for admission.
- h) Candidates should produce conversion formula of their CGPA score if the same is not specifically stated in the Mark list or Certificate.

VII. Submission of Applications


- a) Applications should be filled online logging on to the website www.dtekerala.gov.in or www.cet.ac.in. The different entries in the application are to be filled with extreme care, as this information is used for preparing the rank list. After submitting the application online, an application fee of Rs 500/- (Rs 250/- in case of SC/ST Candidates) is to be remitted in any specified branch of State Bank of India. A printout of the filled up application should be taken and sent with self attested copies of the following documents, to **the Principal, College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram-695 016.**
- b) Engineering Degree certificate and all Mark lists . Those who are appearing for final examination in this year must produce mark list up to 6th Semester for B Tech and 8th Semester for B Arch students
- c) GATE Score card (for Candidates with valid GATE Score)
- d) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate or Income and Community Certificate issued by the village officer for candidates who claim eligibility under SEBC (OBC) quota.
- e) Community Certificate issued by the Tahsildar for candidates who claim eligibility for reservation under SC/ST quota.
- f) The candidates who belong to OEC category should submit the community and Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the Tahsildar / Village Officer.
- g) Sponsorship Certificate and relevant Govt.order (for Sponsored Candidates)
- h) Differently abled certificate (if applicable).
- i) Diploma Certificate for B.Tech Lateral Entry students.

VIII. Selection of Candidates

1. For Institutions in Annexure A and Annexure B

- a) Candidates will have to register their option while submitting the application.
- b) The selection of Candidates will be supervised by the selection committee consisting of the Director of Technical Education (Chairman), the Senior Joint Director (ECS) and the Principal, College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram. The Principal, College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram will be the co-ordinator and venue of admission work is College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram.
- c) Selection of candidates will be based on the GATE score. In case of tie, advantage will be given to the candidates who secure highest aggregate percentage of marks up to 6th semester in their qualifying examination (8th semester for B.Arch students).
- d) If sufficient GATE qualified candidates are not available, the selection will be made from Keralite candidates based on the aggregate percentage of marks up to 6th semester in their qualifying examination (8th semester for B.Arch students). Candidates who produce Nativity Certificate in original obtained as per Annexure- C, at the time of admission will only be admitted in this case. A Rank List will be published based on the GATE Score/Percentage of marks. Candidates are requested to verify their branch/Marks/Category etc. at the time of publishing draft Rank List. After finalizing the Rank List, any alteration on those factors will not be entertained under any circumstances
- e) Allotment list will be published in the websites, www.dtekerala.gov.in and www.cet.ac.in.
- f) Allotment letter can be downloaded from the website www.dtekerala.gov.in or www.cet.ac.in. Selected candidates have to remit the fee on or before the last date in any of the specified branches of State Bank of India. Otherwise, the admission will be cancelled.
- g) Sponsored candidates, if any, will be admitted as per relevant Government Orders.
- h) Transfer Certificate issued from the institutions last attended must be produced at the time of admission.
- i) The selection of candidates will be provisional and subject to verification of original documents by the Principal concerned at the time of admission.
- j) Candidates who get college changes in the subsequent allotments, including spot admission by the DTE are to be relieved in time. The amount collected from such candidates by the respective institutions should be refunded in full.

- b) Institutions will conduct admission by themselves from this rank list, after inviting separate applications and ascertaining the eligibility for admission as per the norms of the University and following the statutory reservation policy. For filling up of 50% Seats, the Principals concerned should resort the Rank List published by the Directorate of Technical Education, and in the absence of candidates in the Rank List by Directorate of Technical Education, other eligible candidates from the Rank List prepared by the institutions can be considered.

IX Remittance of fee & Refund of fee

- a) The fee for a course allotted to the candidate will have to be paid within the stipulated time at any branch of State Bank of India. Any other mode of payment other than through SBI will not be accepted. The fees collected from candidates will be transferred to the College where the candidate stands admitted on closing of admissions.
- b) Refund of fee will be applicable only to students who leave the college on cancellation of admission on or before the closing date of admission. The amount of fee collected will be refunded to the candidates only after the closing of admission process for the year. No interest will be paid to the candidates.

XI No Liquidated Damages

As per G.O(Rt)No.77/2019/H.Edn dated 18.01.2019, the liquidated damages are fully exempted and stated that the clause of chapter 7.13 of AICTE approval process Hand Book 2019-20 stated as follows.

- X1.1 In the event of a student withdrawing before the start of the course, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) and proportionate deductions of monthly fees and hostel rent, where applicable.
- X1.2 In case, if a student leaves after joining the course and if the vacated seat is consequently filled by another student by the last date of admission, the Institution must refund the fee collected after a deductions of processing fee not more than Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) and proportionate deductions of monthly fees and hostel rent, where applicable.

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- X1.3 In case the vacated seat is not filled, the Institution should refund the security deposit and return the original documents.
- X1.4 The Institution should not demand fee for the subsequent years from the students cancelling their admission at any point of time. Fee refund along with the return of certificates should be completed within 7 days.
- X1.5 Institution not following guidelines issued by the council regarding refund of fee for cancellation of admission or delaying refunds shall be liable to anyone or more of the following punitive actions by the council.
- X1.6 Institutions not following guidelines issued by the AICTE regarding refund of fee for cancellation of admission or delaying refunds shall be liable to any one or more of the following punitive actions by the council.
- Fine for Non-Compliance of refund rules of the fee levied against each case shall be five times the total fee collected per student
 - Suspension of approval for NRI and supernumerary seats, if any, for one academic year
 - Reduction in "Approved Intake"
 - No admission in one / more courses (s) for one academic year withdrawal of approval for Programme(s)/Course(s)

XII Spot Admission

- a) A centralized spot admission will be conducted for the vacant seats if any in the courses specified in Annexure A and B on a date fixed later. All students in the rank list are eligible to appear for spot admission. Candidates selected for admission through spot admission will have to join the respective institutions on the date specified by remitting the required fees at the respective Institution.
- b) Those who are admitted in any institutions through centralized allotment can appear for centralized spot admission without NOC from the Principals of respective institutions. All other candidates should produce Original Certificates/ mark lists at the time of spot admission. The Principals should issue T.C and release all Certificates and other relevant documents of candidates who obtained allotment through Centralized Spot Admission without any further delay.
- c) In case seats remains vacant, after the centralized spot admission, the respective institutions can conduct their own spot admission by observing reservation norms as specified in clause IV by giving wide publicity. A separate Rank list may be prepared for the same.

XIII Teaching /Departmental Assistant ships.

All students shall undertake 8 hours of work per week related to teaching and research activities as assigned by the institutions.

XIV Scholarship


Scholarship is available for candidates with valid GATE Score as per AICTE norms for the total period of 24 months subject to the following conditions.

- a) The student shall give an undertaking to the effect that he/she will not leave the course midway or appear for any Competitive examination not related to Engineering and Technology.
- b) The students shall not receive any emoluments, salary, stipend etc. from any other source during the course of study.
- c) The Students eligible to receive GATE Scholarship should have valid bank account which is linked with their Aadhar card number

SC/ST students will be eligible for stipend as per Kerala State Government Rules.

Any other details not specifically covered by the clause given will be decided by the Director of Technical Education and his/her decision will be final and also empowered to cancel any admission found to be illegal subsequent to the admission.
