

- The event served as an opportunity for our volunteers to join the nationwide movement towards healthier living.







The winners of the quiz program were acknowledged and awarded prizes, which added an element of competition and motivation to the event.



Community Engagement:





The tasks were successfully completed on the second day of the cleaning initiative, reflecting the dedication and hard work of the volunteers.



Blood Donation Statistics:


A total of 60 blood donations were collected during the event, demonstrating the generosity and compassion of the participants.
