ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE 2016-2017


Objective

- Abetment of ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Public Nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Wrongful confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation
- Physical or psychological humiliation

Functions

- To appraise the students about the contents of the anti-ragging act and to advise them not to involve in the incidents of ragging.

 Preparation of Charts and Banners depicting the seriousness of actions to be taken in case of any ragging incident and to give wide publicity by displaying those banners at salient locations

Punishment those found guilty

As per the UGC norms any student or group of students found guilty of ragging shall be liable to one or more of the following punishment

- 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- 2. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits
- 3. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process
- 4. Withholding results
- 5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 6. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel
- 7. Cancellation of admission
- 8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period
- 10. Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1 lakh
- 11. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.


